

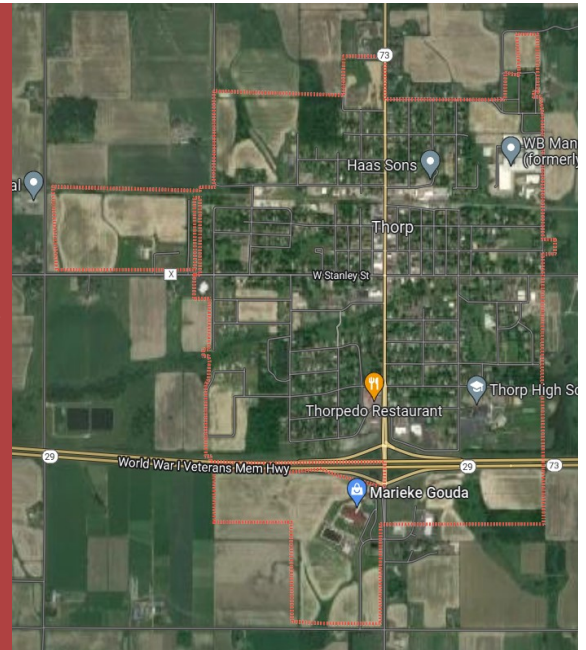


Faith, Family, Work, Loyalty & Respect

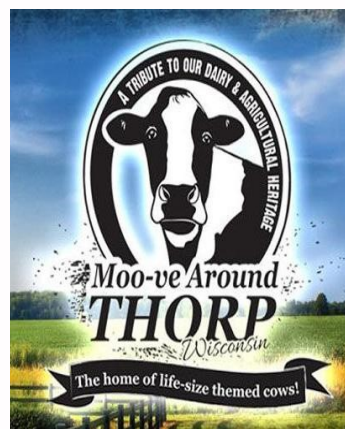
